Establishment of a New AI and DX Promotion Hub in Nagasaki Stadium City

**Recruitment has begun ahead of the October 2026 launch, with a
location agreement signing ceremony with Nagasaki Prefecture and
Nagasaki City scheduled for July**

SocioFuture Co., Ltd. (Minato-ku, Tokyo; Akihiko Sugawara, Representative Director, President and Executive Officer; hereinafter referred to as "the Company") announces that it will establish a new AI and DX promotion hub in August 2026 at STADIUM CITY NORTH, located within Nagasaki Stadium City (Nagasaki City, Nagasaki Prefecture), and plans to commence operations in October of the same year. In line with this, the Company plans to hold a signing ceremony in July 2026 to conclude a location agreement with Nagasaki Prefecture and Nagasaki City. By establishing this new hub, the Company will enhance its technological development capabilities and contribute to regional economic revitalization in Nagasaki Prefecture through job creation.

Under the Company philosophy of Creating a more human-friendly society through high-touch operations, "High Touch for Society," the Company regards this as its mission and provides people-centered (high-touch) services across financial, public, and healthcare sectors, leveraging advanced technologies. To achieve this, the Company defines key front-line service hubs as "HOC (High-Touch Operations Center)" and conducts operations such as back-office services and call center functions at these locations.

The newly established hub will be built on the foundation of HOC operations, while distinguishing itself from conventional

HOCs as a new flagship hub specializing in AI and DX promotion. It has been named the “Frontier Creation Center Nagasaki (hereinafter referred to as ‘FCCN’).” As a result, the total number of HOCs Nagasaki Prefecture, Nagasaki Stadium City within the Company’s group will reach 52, making this the second base in Nagasaki Prefecture following the Sasebo HOC (Sasebo City, Nagasaki Prefecture), which was established in 2011. In addition, in preparation for the establishment in August 2026 and the commencement of operations in October, the Company will begin full-scale recruitment activities in Nagasaki Prefecture. By providing an environment at Nagasaki Stadium City equipped with the latest facilities, where employees can work while engaging with cutting-edge technologies, the Company aims to contribute to the development of IT talent and the revitalization of the regional economy.

In the future, in collaboration with Nagasaki Prefecture, Nagasaki City, and the Nagasaki Industrial Promotion Foundation, the Company is considering participating in joint research and human resource development programs with local universities and companies, and aims to contribute to the creation of regional innovation.

Accordingly, in concluding the location agreement, the Company will strive to contribute to IT technology development and job creation that support the revitalization of the regional economy in Nagasaki Prefecture, with the support of Nagasaki Prefecture and Nagasaki City.
